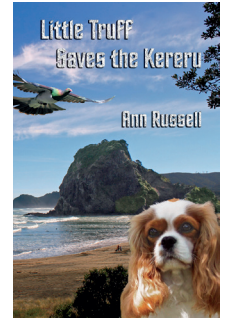

Refer to Chapter 2. Find 4 good reasons why the kererū MUST be saved and list them by the bullet points below.

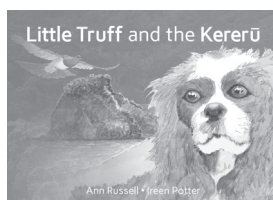
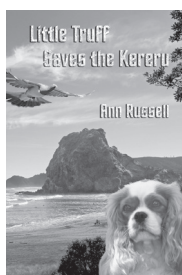
