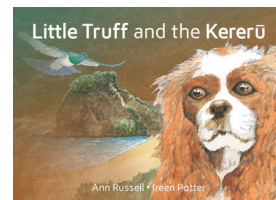


The Kererū Crossword Puzzle

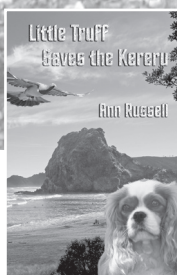
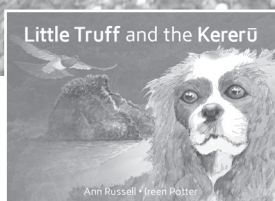
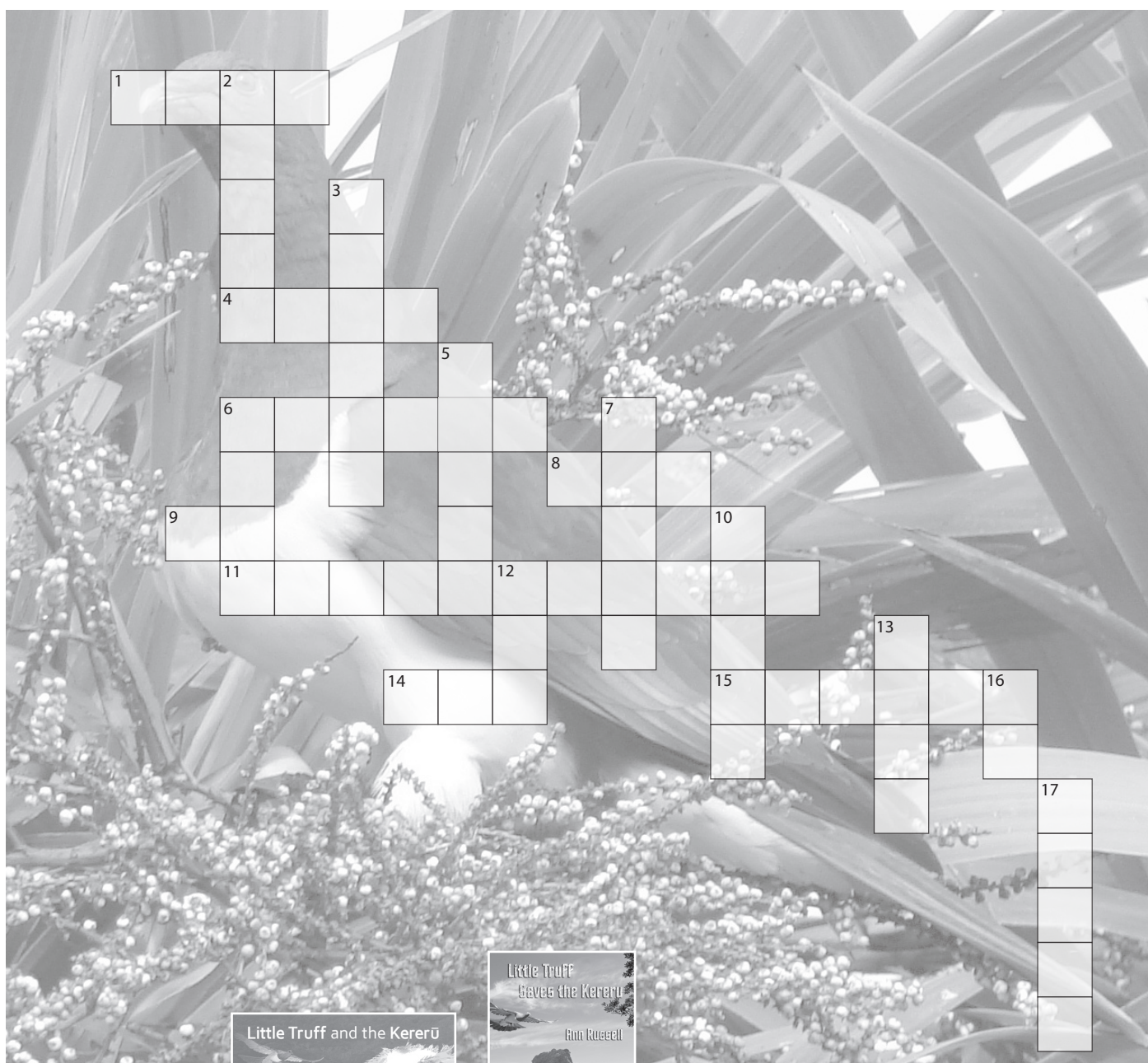


ACROSS:
